## Vincent Edward Smith (1915-1972)

The recent tragic death of Vincent Smith in New York on May 18 is cause for special sorrow for us both as editors of this journal and for the lengthy and fruitful friendship we have enjoyed with him. The New Scholasticism benefitted enormously from his capable and imaginative editing for eighteen years, from 1948 through 1966.
